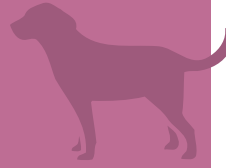

Additional information

- Highly digestible food to support healthy digestion
- Specific protein (whole egg) and carbohydrate (brewers' rice) sources help limit signs of food intolerances.
- Provides complete balanced nutrition for adult dogs and is suitable for long term feeding.

For increased palatability, the dry formula is coated with hydrolysed animal proteins, which are very unlikely to elicit allergic reactions.

COMPOSITION DRY

Brewers' rice, dried whole egg, maize gluten meal, animal fat, barley, oats, minerals, digest, cellulose, soybean oil, L-lysine, vitamins, taurine, trace elements, and beta-carotene. With a natural antioxidant (mixed tocopherols).
